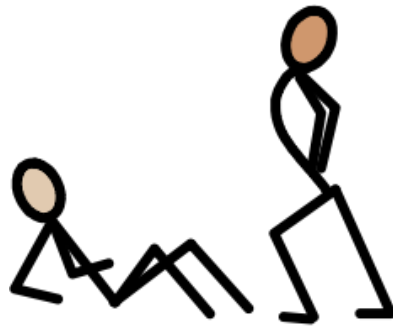

What is bullying?



“Bullying is the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal, or psychological. It can happen face to face or online.”



Verbal

This can be name calling, insults, teasing or saying something that upsets someone



Physical

This can be hitting, kicking, tripping or damaging property. When someone is physically hurt.

Cyber

This is bullying online or through a device such as a phone or tablet. It could be nasty messages or sharing information online.

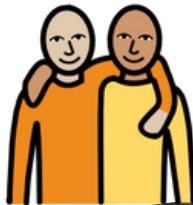

Ask why?



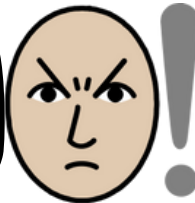
Ignore them

Don't keep it a secret!



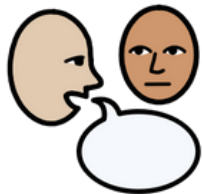
What should I do if I see someone else being bullied?



Encourage your friend to speak up straight away.



Help them to tell an adult, or tell someone yourself
