RETURN TO SCHOOL – WEDNESDAY 3RD SEPTEMBER 2025

Dear parents/ carers,

We hope that you have had a fantastic summer break and are as excited as we are for our return to school next week! I just wanted to share some important information with yourselves ahead of our return to ensure the reopening is as smooth as possible.

WELCOME

We are really excited to welcome our new Foundation 1 and 2 children to the Leamington community. Starting the education journey is so important and we're really excited to be a part of it! Children enter school via the front of the building. Doors open at 8:35am for children and parents to come in and settle for the day.

Further welcome to Miss Parker, Miss Featherstone and Mr Plant who join the teaching team. Welcome to Ms Middleton who joins the EYFS team.

Mrs B Rodgers gave birth during the break to a health baby boy, Douglas. We send her lots of love and best wishes. Miss Joy begins her maternity leave, before welcoming her little girl later in the year.

ATTENDING SITE

Please can we ask that children are accompanied onto site by an adult, unless they are in Year 5 and 6 and walking to school alone. There is no adult supervision on site before 8:35am. We ask that when attending site, you come straight to the classrooms and do not allow children to play football, especially at the front of school. This is purely for safety reasons.

Timings of the school day:

8:35am – doors open for breakfast

8:45am- registers taken – children arriving after this time will be recorded as late

11:30am – morning nursery finishes

12:30pm – afternoon nursery starts

3:15pm – school closes for the day

YEAR 2/3

The children in Year 2 and 3 will enter school via the back end of the building. We ask that at 8:35am the children come down the path and then onto the playground, around the astro and up the stairs near the field. This will reduce congestion and ensure a more settled start to the day. There will be adults on hand to support children as we return to school.

At the end of the day, the children will exit from the bottom doors and meet parents on the playground. Please wait on the playground so that we can ensure children and parents are reunited safely. Children are not to be collected from the stairs area.

BIKES/ SCOOTERS

Children are welcome to bring bikes/ scooters on site and leave them in the bike shelters. It is crucial that children dismount their bikes/ scooters as they enter site. We want

everyone to be able to access site safely and this is a risk when bikes/ scooters are ridden on site.

UNIFORM

We are incredibly proud of our sense of belonging at Leamington. Our school uniform is a representation of who we are as a school community. Please ensure your child is in school uniform for our return to school. Full black trainers can be worn as school shoes.

PE uniform also needs to be worn. Plain black/ grey joggers can be worn, but please avoid branded items.

COMMUNICATION WITH SCHOOL

Effective communication is so important between home and school. If you wish to speak to a member of school staff, please contact the class teacher to make an appointment. Class Dojo can be used between 8am and 5pm. Any messages received outside of these hours will be picked up and responded to within 48 hours.

If you need to speak to a member of the leadership team, an appointment will need to be made either through Dojo or the school office. Please note, parental communication is extremely important to us, but we also have commitments to fulfil in school.

Dates for the term will be sent out on our return, along with dates that will appear on Dojo and the school website. Please ensure you check these regularly as we are always adding exciting events for the children and families in school.

PARENTPAY

ParentPay is our online payment and booking system. If you wish for your child to have a cooked meal in school, this needs to be pre ordered.

If you are new to school, log in details will be provided on entry.

If you do not order a meal and wish your child to have a cooked meal, they will be given the tomato pasta option with fruit for dessert. Meals are cooked to order, so it is really important that meals are booked in advance to support the kitchen.

ParentPay is also used to give permission and make payments for visits/ visitors. Without support from parents, these wonderful opportunities cannot happen for the children.

We're really excited to see all of the children and families back where they belong. Autumn launches our Geography enquiry with lots of exciting knowledge for the children to learn!
